A message from your vicar, Revd David Cattle

"Living on Holy Saturday"

Well, it's finally happened – I finally caught Covid! Thankfully, I wasn't too badly affected by it. It was a bad cold and a mild flu for me, followed by some extra tiredness and loss of taste and smell for a few days. Nothing too bad. I know some people have been really badly affected by it, so I feel thankful to have got off lightly.

Anyway, my brush with Covid is trivial compared with the problems facing the world at the moment. We thought we had it bad with the pandemic, but then Mr Putin decided he wanted to get his old empire back, starting with Ukraine. The people of that country are having misery poured out on them every day. It's hard to imagine what they must be facing. We've seen some distressing images on our TV screens, but I suspect that's only the tip of the iceberg.

And then we are having a cost of living crisis in this country, resulting from the pandemic and the war, but having deeper roots in the systemic inequalities in the Western countries. I know that a lot of people are struggling at the moment, with even worse to come.

It was great to see that Christians in Ukraine still managed to celebrate Easter recently, in the midst of everything that is going on there. And here in St Michael's Church in Galleywood we also held our usual Easter celebrations (and it was wonderful to welcome local schools and nurseries into Church for Easter celebrations too). On Good Friday, we remember that Jesus died on the cross around 2,000 years ago, and on Easter Sunday we celebrate our belief that God raised him from the dead on the third day after his crucifixion.

Good Friday tells us that God joins us in the misery and suffering of human life. He is not a god who sits up there on a cloud drinking a cappuccino while we suffer down here on earth; instead he became human in the Person of Jesus (which we celebrate at Christmas), and joined us in our human condition.

And on Easter Sunday, we celebrate that the love of God is the strongest force in the universe, even stronger than death itself. Death is defeated and everything is made new. This shows us what the ultimate fate of the whole creation is – God will make everything right with the creation, and suffering and death will be no more, and all will be well.

At the moment, we live as people of the inbetween times – we are caught in between Good Friday (with its suffering and misery and death) and Easter Sunday (with its promise of new life to come). It's like we live on Holy Saturday. In my Easter Sunday sermon, I challenged the congregation to think about how we should live as people of Holy Saturday, and I gave them two suggestions:

Firstly, we can be people of hope, since we know that God has raised Jesus from the dead, and therefore we know that the ultimate fate of all things is goodness and love, not death and suffering and injustice. We know where everything is headed, no matter bad things are right now. That doesn't make everything all right, but it does give us a hope for the future.

Secondly, we can be people who live with love and goodness in our hearts. We can provide the antidote the craziness we see on our tellies. We can be people of peace, justice, empathy, and care for others; people who never give up praying for others and asking God to bless them; and people who refuse the way of fear and selfishness.

I think this is the right response to world's problems – have hope, and live good lives. And, as we say in Church on Easter Sunday, "Alleluia, Christ is risen! He is risen indeed. Alleluia!"

Welcome to Galleywood Parish Council's Annual Report. This summarises the work of the Council for the last financial year. At the time of writing, the Parish Council office has returned to normal opening hours and public meetings in person have returned.

The weekly Youth Club is funded by the Parish Council in conjunction with YMCA Essex and held in the Youth Centre in Watchouse Road on a Thursday evening.



Committees

In Memory Of David Stevenson

It is with the deepest sadness that we inform you that David Stevenson has passed away on the 1st March 2022.

Galleywood said goodbye to its longest serving Parish Councillor, David Stevenson, with a celebration of his life on the 7th April 2022 at St Michael's Church in the village. It is the end of an era for the community of Galleywood as he was a founder member of Galleywood Parish council when it was created in 1987. He was first elected in 1979 to represent Galleywood on the then joint Galleywood and Great Baddow Parish Council.

He served on all the committees of the Parish Council over the years, including a period as Chairman, thus serving Galleywood Parish Council for an amazing 41 years before his reluctant retirement due to poor health in 2020.

David was born in West Ham in 1941 and grew up in Pilgrims Hatch, where he still had family and many friends. David was an electrician by trade. Geraldine (Gen) and David married and had their only daughter, Elizabeth. When Liz was three years old, they moved to Galleywood where, after a short time, David became a Parish Councillor. Herewith began his love of local politics.

David was also one of our longest serving Councillors on the Borough/City Council. He was first elected to the then Chelmsford Borough Council in 1987 representing the Old Moulsham ward, with a break of just four years, after which he proudly represented Galleywood for 30 years until 2019. He served on countless committees, receiving awards along the way for long service on the City Council and also the Parish Council.

David was Chairman of Keene Hall for 11 years. He was very active in local clubs and committees, Church, PCC, Galleywood Common Association, Conservative club, Heritage Centre, and Historical Society. He was also a member of the Galleywood Social Club and a member of the Camera Club as taking local photos was a real passion for him.

He was an active member of the Conservative Association for over 45 years, and very much enjoyed canvassing the parishioners and constituents which gave him the opportunity to talk and socialise with people.

David had a wonderful light-hearted humour, at times finishing his jokes with a chuckle, sometimes before he delivered the punch line! He was a lovely, gentle man. A true gentleman. Always ready to help others, so active for his charities, standing for hours collecting for the poppy appeal for the Royal British legion, despite his difficulties with his own mobility. He also supported the Friends of the Samaritans and BLESMA, hence his request of donations for these three charities in his memory. He worked tirelessly for them all, sitting on the committees and helping with anything he could.

He served his community with unlimited enthusiasm and empathy for all his constituents. He always had time for anyone who has contacted him with a problem, and always did his very best to find a solution when possible. The condolences messages received have been a testament to Davids' kindness and dedication to his village and his constituents. Such kind messages saying how he was a pillar of the community and a piece of Galleywood history has left us.

David was a person who loved life, his family, and his friends. David will be sadly missed but

he will be remembered always with great affection for his commitment to his constituents and his passion for the village of Galleywood. He enriched the lives of people who were fortunate and blessed to know him. He will clearly be greatly missed by his family, his many friends, council colleagues, and, of course, the villagers of Galleywood.



First Essex Buses: Service Change

From Sunday 17th April we are making changes to your bus networks across the county.

These changes are in response to the change in our travel habits; people are travelling less often and have less certainty about how many times a day or week they require travel.

These changes are designed to deliver sustainable networks which are easier to use and continue to provide the ability to travel around the towns and villages across the county on our services.

Some buses will run earlier and later in the day, some more often, some less often, and there will be new networks in the Basildon, Chelmsford, and Colchester areas. Buses that connect the local suburbs to the centre of Basildon, Chelmsford, and Colchester will be replaced by locally focussed services with simple, regular timetables, and simple, easy to use fares starting at £2.50 for an adult and with new, newer, or fully-refurbished vehicles being introduced over the coming months with a new red-based colour scheme.

The services that we provide to connect other towns and cities to these locations and each other will also start to see new, newer, or fully-refurbished vehicles being introduced and will become Essex Bus services in our new exciting green-based colour scheme.



We have already simplified the fares in Chelmsford and Colchester and, from the same date (17th April), we will be bringing the same flexible way to pay for bus travel by introducing Tap & Cap to Basildon.

Unfortunately, we are having to increase a small number of ticket prices in South Essex. However, we are not increasing any other fares at this time in recognition of the fact we are all paying more for daily essentials. Fares increases will be necessary in the future as our costs are also increasing, but we will try and keep these increases to a minimum.

The Baddow & Galleywood U3A

We will begin with a (very) brief history of who we are.

The Baddow and Galleywood u3a was formed in 1998 after the Chelmsford u3a became so popular that it could no longer cater for all those wanting to take part in its activities. Since then, our local u3a has grown to having well over 300 members itself!

Anyone in their 'third age' and not in full-time employment can join. The U3A is essentially a self-help organisation with members setting up, leading, and taking part in groups based on their own interests. Groups can be creative, such as photography or music, active such as walking, cultural such as history or social such as cooking. At present we have approximately 25 groups, so there should be something for everyone's taste, and if by any chance, that's not the case, then we welcome new interest groups being formed. Several are in the pipeline since you read our article in the Winter/Spring issue.

We hold a general meeting, usually on the first Monday of each month, with an invited professional speaker.
