## Your vote matters on 4 May 2023

## This May, local elections are happening to elect councillors to all wards across Chelmsford City Council, as well as some parishes.

Councillors make important decisions about your local area so make sure to vote and have your say! Everything you need to know about the elections can be found at

Chelmsford City Council covers a wide range of services, such as:

- Leisure, parks and culture
- Housing and benefits support
- Environmental services and waste collection

If you live in an area with a Parish Council, or other type of local council (e.g. Community Council) they could be responsible for additional services including allotments, play areas and community centres.

## **Registering to vote**

You need to register before you can vote in UK elections and referendums. You can do this at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote. You do not need to re-register to vote for each election, so if you voted in the last elections and nothing has changed (i.e., you haven't moved house or changed your name), then you do not need to do anything.

To vote in these elections you must register by Monday 17th April.

## Photo ID is needed to vote

The UK government has decided that voters must show photo identification when voting in person. There are lots of different versions of ID that will be accepted for this, including passports, driving licences, bus passes and blue badges - even if they are expired, as long as the picture still looks like you!

If you don't have any ID that you can use, you can apply for a voter authority certificate for free before Tuesday 25th April. Visit

## Postal and proxy votes

If you will be away or can't make it to your polling station on 4th May 2023, you can apply

to vote by post or by proxy on the Chelmsford City Council website:

If you set up a postal vote, ballot papers will be sent to you by post before the election and you just need to return them by 10pm on polling day. Apply for a postal vote for the May 2023 elections by 5pm on Tuesday 18th April 2023.

A proxy vote allows you to appoint someone that you trust to cast your vote for you at your polling station. To vote by proxy for these elections you must apply by Tuesday 25th April 2023.

## Could you be a councillor?

If you want to get involved in local democracy, then you can either stand as a representative of a political party (with the authorisation of the party) or as an independent candidate. The deadline for nominating yourself is Tuesday 4th April 2023. A briefing session will take place in early March. Find out more at www.chelmsford.gov.uk/voting-andelections/stand-for-election/

# A message from your Vicar, Revd David Cattle

"Keep on rocking!"

When times are hard, one thing that really cheers me up is listening to loud rock music, with shredding guitars, explosive drums, and all the rest. No, this is not my mid-life crisis – maybe it's more a case that I'm stuck in my teens!

One of my favourite singers has just released a new album with a song containing these words: "Yeah. I know you're struggling right now – we all are, in different ways. It's like a new world that we don't even know. It's hard to sleep, even harder to dream."

It's a song which recognises that, for most of us, life is harder than it used to be. The song is called "Hanging on by a thread (don't give up)", and it is written to encourage those of us who are struggling at the moment. The song even finishes by advising people to call the Suicide Prevention Hotline in the USA if they need that. When times are tough, don't give up.

And who is the author of this modern-day song of encouragement? None other than the great American rocker Alice Cooper! That might sound weird, but there are hidden depths to Alice Cooper (or Vincent Furnier, as (I hope!) his family calls him). When you listen to him being interviewed, he comes across as the most intelligent rocker you've ever heard (and he probably is). He has a history of mentoring other people in the music industry, especially those who are struggling to beat addictions to one substance or another. He is also a committed Christian believer, who goes to Church every Sunday. You might not guess it from his gory, vaudeville-style, comedy stage show, but there you go. He is also still making great music in his mid-70s.

I reckon this outburst of positivity (from someone who usually sings songs which are much darker than this) shows his Christian faith bubbling up to the surface. He believes that Jesus died 2,000 years ago to take away our sins, showing that God is firmly on the side of struggling humanity. And he believes that God raised Jesus from the dead on the third day, which shows that life and love are ultimately stronger than death and evil.

The message of Easter is that there is hope for the future, no matter how bad life gets. Life is always worthwhile and valuable. Recently, my daughter, who was six at the time, said to me, "Daddy, don't give up". I'm not sure what she thought she meant by that, but I will take it as an encouragement, and as a sign that God is with us.

Everyone is welcome to join us at St Michael's Church for our special family service at 10am on Easter Sunday (9th April).

The next song on Alice's album is called "Shut up and rock!" That sounds like a good plan for the rest of my day!

# Make a change – Become a councillor

## Local Elections are taking place on Thursday 4th May 2023.

These elections are for Chelmsford City Council and Galleywood Parish Council.

### **Become a Parish Councillor**

Galleywood Parish Council is calling on residents who are passionate about their community to stand for election in the May 2023 parish elections. Your local knowledge and commitment could make a real difference.

### What do local councillors do?

Local Councillors are the champions of their community and give residents a voice on the decisions the council makes.

Becoming a local councillor will allow you to make a real difference in your community by engaging with residents, local groups and businesses to find out their needs; making decisions on which services and projects the council should take forward and getting involved locally to ensure the services are meeting your community's needs.

### How long does it take?

The National Association of Local Councils (NALC) Local Councillor Census Survey found that councillors put aside, on average, 3 hours a week for council work. This often includes attending meetings, engaging with residents and speaking on behalf of the council to other bodies.

#### Can I stand?

Most people are qualified to stand for election to their local council but there are a few rules. You must be:

- At least 18 years of age on or before the day of the election:
- British, Qualifying Commonwealth or EU citizen

In addition, you must meet one or more of the following qualifications:

- On the electoral register for the parish and remain on it for the duration of the term of office. and/or
- Occupied as an owner or tenant any land or premises in the parish for the whole 12 months before the date of nomination and the date of the election, and/or
- Main or only place of work during the whole 12 months before the date of nomination and the date of the election is in the parish and/or
- Lived within 3 miles (4.8km) of the parish during the whole 12 months before the date of nomination and the date of the election

Nomination forms must be submitted in person (by the candidate or someone on their behalf)


