

Welcome to our Spring edition of the Grapevine magazine.

I recall writing in the last edition that it wouldn't be much longer before we were enjoying

warmer Spring weather; well, it may not be as warm as we would like, but at least as I look out of the window the trees are green and the blossom is out. We hope you enjoyed the spring bulbs planted last autumn by volunteers in various patches of grass in the village; thank you to everyone who helped with this. There is a lovely display of cowslips ('peggles' if you come from Galleywood) at Twitten Green this year; the Parish Council has been nurturing this patch of grass for several years now to encourage the cowslips and wildflowers, which is why you will notice that this remains uncut in the spring and summer months.

The Annual Parish Meeting on April 11 was well attended, and our speakers were excellent; there is a report and photographs later in this edition. I'm sorry I couldn't be there to chair the meeting because of a nasty virus; thank you to Councillor Potter for standing in for me at the last minute.

The Parish Council has arranged for three new benches to be installed in Jubilee Park; this will be completed in the next few weeks. One of these is a 'Happy to Chat' bench which we hope will encourage people to stay for a while and talk to their neighbours. Thank you to Essex County Council for funding this through its Locality Fund, and to Chelmsford City Council for installing the benches.

There are some important upcoming events for your diary. First, the Parish Council will be hosting a service outside the Keene Hall on June 6 to commemorate the 80th anniversary of the D-Day landings. There will also be an open day on July 6 at the Keene Hall to showcase the many voluntary organisations in

Galleywood; all of these would be grateful for any time and skills you might be able to give to support them. Further details can be found later in this edition.

Finally, a note about forthcoming electoral boundary changes. There will be a general election before the end of January 2025.

The Boundary Commission for England has determined that Galleywood ward will be moved to Maldon constituency for the purposes of electing a member of Parliament.

We have had a few questions about the implications of this; please be reassured that there is no change at all to your relationship with the County Council, the City Council, or the Parish Council. If you have any questions about the change, please call me, the Clerk, or one of your Parish Councillors.

As usual, Councillor surgeries are on the last Saturday of each month (except August and December) from 10 am – 12 noon in the Galleywood Library, so please come along to meet your Parish Councillors and to discuss local issues. We really would like to see you there. Alternatively, you can contact the Parish Council office at any time by telephone, 01245 358898/348756, email clerk@galleywoodparishcouncil.gov.uk or in person on weekday mornings.

A message from your Vicar, Revd David Cattle

What a wonderful place for a wedding!

For those couples thinking of getting engaged, did you know

that as a resident of Galleywood Parish you have an automatic legal right to get married in St Michael's Church? You can also get married here if you have an historic or family connection with the parish or the Church. Sadly, I need to turn away some couples who would love to get married here but who don't live near here and don't have any connection.

Why get married at St Michael's? For starters, it is a very beautiful building, with its stained-glass windows, mosaics, lovely wooden furniture, and warm colours. It is a very photogenic Church. And then there is the beauty of its setting – on Galleywood Common, surrounded by our beautiful, peaceful churchyard.

And then there are the bells. Our wonderful bell-ringers can be booked to ring at the end of your wedding service, so you come out of the Church as husband and wife to the sound of the bells, announcing the joy of your marriage to the whole village!

And then there is the personal service that the Church offers.

I spend time with couples to plan their ceremony, and by the time the wedding comes around they know me well and they are pleased that I am leading their service.

I make it personal for them.

The Church also offers a free marriage preparation day in May each year, which includes a candle-lit lunch for every couple.

And then there is the mixture of old and new, the traditional and the modern. All of our weddings use the standard vows, and you can add some words of your own if you would like. For music, we can book an organist to play, you can play pop songs on our sound system, and you can book other musicians to play live.

And then there is the mixture of formality and fun. Yes, the service is quite formal in parts, with solemn things happening, but the service is also fun and joyful – we make it a day to enjoy as well as remember.

But, of course, the most important reason for wanting to get married in Church is if you have faith in God, and value a spiritual dimension to your marriage. A wedding in Church reminds us that marriage is a gift from God, and that God cares about your marriage and wants it to be a thing of real beauty. The service puts us in touch with something deeper, something bigger than ourselves.

Weddings are just one of the ways that the Church serves its community here in Galleywood. If you would like to know more, please contact me.


Photography Competition

ANNUAL REPORT 2023/2024



Welcome to Galleywood Parish Council's Annual Report. This summarises the work of the Council for the last financial year.

Councillor Stephanie Troop,

Parish Councils are statutory bodies and are the first tier of local government. Galleywood Parish Council is made up of 9 Councillors supported by the Clerk and Admin Assistant. The Parish Council receives an income from Chelmsford City Council. This is know as the 'Precept', which residents pay as part of their council tax. Through an extensive range of Powers we provide and maintain a variety of important and visible local services. Your Parish Councillors are volunteers; they do not receive an allowance from the Parish council.

Meetings

The Parish Council meets at least every other month and it is at these meetings where decisions are made. Meetings are open to the public and there is an opportunity for residents to ask questions about agenda items. Some of the Parish Council's work is undertaken at Committee meetings which are also open to the public. The Parish Council Committees are as follows:

Finance and Resources Committee - Ensures the Council abides by agreed Financial Regulations; reviews the Parish Council's assets; manages the Parish Council's grants scheme; delivers the annual programme of events; controls the provision of the Youth Club. Sets the budget and monitors expenditure.


Personnel Committee - considers the levels of staffing; reviews staffing policies, including training needs.


